Champagne

Moet & Chandon Imperial Brut

Btl R2965

(Wine of Origin: Eperney, France)

Vibrant notes of green apple and citrus fruits on the nose, hints of white flowers and aromas of brioche and fresh nuts.

Moet & Chandon Nectar

Btl R3210

(Wine of Origin: Eperney, France)

On tasting, Nectar Imperial Champagne inspires a characteristic universe featuring golden, brilliant, shimmering tones.

A marbled gold with darker shades and fire agate stone from Mexico.

Veuve Clicquot Brut NV Yellow Label

Btl R3565

(Wine of Origin: Eperney, France)

This Champagne manages to combine strength and silkiness, and to hold them in perfect balance with aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness.

Veuve Clicquot Rich

Btl R4055

(Wine of Origin: Reims, France)

The signature notes of the wine are selected ingredients such as pineapple, grapefruit zest, cucumber, celery, peppers or tea. The majority grape variety used in this remarkable Champagne is Pinot Noir (45%), followed by Meunier (35%) and Chardonnay (20%).

Method Cap Classique

Alvi's Drift Brut Rose

Btl R400

(Wine Of Origin: Breede River Valley)

Notes of crisp green apple with hints of strawberry, watermelon and pomegranate on the nose, following through to the palate. A lively mousse, it is a clean, fresh and unpretentious wine with a dry finish that offers subtle hints of Watermelon, and candyfloss.

Kleine Zalze Brut

Btl R480

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

A traditional MCC, showing elegance and complexity with a long finish.

Aromas of strawberry and blackberry fruit flavours complemented by classic biscuit bouquet richness. A lively fine mousse transforms this wine into an unforgettable sparkling sensation.

Kleine Zalze Brut Rose

Btl R510

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

A delicate silver pink hue with a lively cascading sparkle, aromas of cherries and red berries with elegant layers of finesse on the palate.

Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut

Btl R560

(Wine of Origin: Reims, France)

Aromas of dried apple rings with layers of apricot and red cherries. The flavour of freshly baked bread comforts the palate. A youthful mousse.



Sauvignon Blanc

Mulderbosch 2022

Btl R340 | Gls R85

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Characterised by a zesty grapefruit texture, the palate possesses a bracing mineral core and thrilling fruit flavours of freshly sliced rock melon and ripe green figs.

Guardian Peak 2022

Btl R360 | Gls R90

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Bright tropical fruit, with typical notes of granadilla, Cape gooseberry and lime cordial. Intense fruit on the palate is lifted by a crisp and refreshing acidity, with a Touch of salinity.

Catherine Marshall 2022

Btl R470

(Wine of Origin: Elgin)

Mouth filling flavours of citrus, lime sorbet and a core of ripe nectarine, blackcurrant flesh with a long, pure line of pink grapefruit on the finish.

Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection 2022

Btl R500

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Intense flavours of gooseberries, kiwi and a slight herbal interest.

The palate reveals layers of complexity with mineral structure and greened notes.

Cape Point Vineyards 2019

Btl R650

(Wine of Origin: Noordhoek)

This wine shows beautiful fruit aromas – ripe nectarine, passionfruit, gooseberries and fig.

The wines' palate is full and flavoured with racy acidity. Hints of oak spice gives the wine an extra layer of depth.

Chardonnay

Vriesenhof Unwooded 2022

Btl R340 | Gls R85

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

The wine is light and refreshing and bursting with fruit.

Fresh citrus with a zesty acidity and hints of gooseberries and green apples.

Alvi's Drift Reserve 2012

Btl R480 | Gls R120

(Wine of Origin: Breede River Valley)

Pale – straw coloured with flashes of lime green towards the meniscus. Inviting aromas of lemon cream, butter and peach blossom. Fruit character which leads to a clean, lemony finish.

De Wetshof Finesse 2021

Btl R480

(Wine of Origin: Robertson)

Bright straw colour. Some notes of yellow fruit, vanilla and butter, round palate with sufficient freshness and some roasted nutty notes, good freshness and grip on the finish, rather long.

Louis Latour Ardeche 2013

Btl R860

(Wine of Origin: Vin de Pays, France)

Yellow in colour with green hints, with aromas revealing crisp Bosc pear and white peach, wafts of honeycomb, lemon citrus and toasted spices. The palate is creamy and nicely balanced with mouth-watering acidity and a hint of oak.

Paul Cluver 2021

Btl R990

(Wine of Origin: Elgin)

On the nose this wine shows great citrus aspects and winter melon notes with some light toasted brioche in the background. Tangerine fruit and citrus blossom fragrances are apparent, with hints of vanilla pod and almond flakes. These characteristics follow through on the palate.

Cloudy Bay 2012

Btl R2290

(Wine of Origin: Marlborogh, New Zealand)

Offers a beam of fruit intensity with Meyer lemon, tangerine and ruby grapefruit flavours, accented by notes of crushed rock and apricot.



Chenin Blanc

Mulderbosch Steen op Hout 2022

Btl R340 | Gls R85

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

The wine is bright in appearance, with a nose of fresh pears, ripe apricots and subtle oak spice from maturation of just over 40% of the blend in large, matured oak barrels.

DeMorgenzon DMZ 2021

Btl R400

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

This wine is fresh, clean and with tons of bright fruit. Green apple, apricot, peach, hints of honey and floral aromas with a bright and upfront nose. The palate is rich with bold fruit flavours that culminates with a lingering aftertaste..

Guardian Peak 2022

Btl R500 | Gls R125

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Delicate floral perfume of white blossoms is packed up by fresh pear, white pineapple and apple crumble.

Light bodied, fresh and fruity on the palate, with an underlying Note of stoney minerality.

Delaire Graff 2018

Btl R540

(Wine of origin: Swartland)

This wine is characterised by a complex and intense concentration of flavours due to its low-yielding vines. Layered expressions of citrus and tropical fruit surrender to subtle notes of honey and almonds.

Donkiesbaai Steen 2022

Btl R845

(Wine of Origin: Piekenierskloof)

Bold, fruity aromas of pineapple, lime cordial and yellow peach mingled with notes of biscotti and nougat.

Rich and textured on the palate with elderflower, peach and macadamia.

The intensity of the fruit is balanced by well-integrated oak.

Unusual Whites and Blends

Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc 2022

Btl R260 | Gls R65

(Wine of Origin: Constantia)

A full-bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.

Cederberg Bukketraube 2022

Btl R340 | Gls R85

(Wine of Origin: Cederberg)

An aromatic Bukettraube with a distinctive green apple, terpene character followed with hints of honeycomb and white flowers. A vibrant wine with delicate muscat flavour finishing off with a refreshingly sweet and sour sensation.

Alvi's Drift CVC (Chenin/Viognier/Chard) 2019

Btl R435

(Wine of Origin: Breede River Valley)

A lovely pale lemon – straw colour. Peach and apricot characters on the nose. A lovely blend of roasted nuts with a hint of butter-scotch and ripe melons. The palate is balanced with oak, fruit and acidity, all adding to the wines' length and fullness.

Louis Latour Chassagne Montrachet 2011

Btl R1890

(Wine of Origin: Vin de Pays, France)
A complex nose of honeysuckle, yellow peach and hazelnut.
Round and ample on the palate, it lingers on fresh hazelnut aromas.



Viognier

Clive Torr 2014

Btl R500 | Gls R125

(Wine of Origin: Western Cape)

Welcome to the world of Garage Wine. This is a natural wine with a taste of Condrier style peaches.

Easy to drink. Very low in sulphur.

Pinot Grigio

Terra Del Capo 2019

Btl R240 | GIs R60

(Wines of Origin: Franschhoek, Groenekloof, Elgin, Elandskloof)

Grapes from four different regions are used to produce this wine. Subtle whiffs of lemon and orange leaf, peach and stone fruit tempt the nose. The palate offers succulent notes of peach and nectarine fruit with some lemon freshness.

Rose

Kanonkop Pinotage 2020

Btl R300 | Gls R75

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Perfumed and aromatic notes of sweet melon, rose water and summer berries are present on the nose. The acidity is fresh and bright. The palate displays intense flavours of red cherries, red apples, melon & raspberries.

Mulderbosch Cabernet 2021

Btl R320 | Gls R80

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Fresh strawberries and a subtle chalky note define the nose. The palate is framed by beautifully balanced, succulent fruit flavours and a fine, mineral finish.

Warwick The First Lady 2022

Btl R330

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Crisp, dry and delightfully refreshing. Made from a blend of Pinotage and Chardonnay grapes, this rose has aromas of fresh strawberries and cherries, with delicate floral notes.

Pinotage

Beyerskloof Reserve 2020

Btl R620 | Gls R155

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Dry, full-bodied, fruity and wooded. A barrel-matured red wine that boasts intense flavours of blackberry and plum followed by hints of cedar oak on the nose.

Rijk's Touch of Oak 2020

Btl R650

(Wine of Origin: Tulbagh)

Aromas of cranberry and subtle hints of mulberry and Vanilla spice. The lively palate is rich and creamy and finishes with smooth and well-matured tannins.

Kanonkop 2020

Btl R1705

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Deep garnet with a purple hue, this wine offers plush plum and cherry flavours with an evocative hint of spice.

As the wine ages in the bottle, it gains an earthy, forest-floor Character and a delectable cassis-like, sweet-fruited core.



Merlot

Guardian Peak 2021

Btl R360 | Gls R90

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Expressive on the nose with ripe damson plums, cherries and soft nutmeg spice. Refined, mouth-coating tannins balance well with rich fruit flavours of plum and raspberry coulis. Notes of molasses and roasted thyme create complexity.

Catherine Marshall Amatra 2021

Btl R520 | Gls R130

(Wine of Origin: Elgin)

Old single trellised Merlot wines from the Polkadraai area in Stellenbosch exudes bright, fresh black plums. Generous purple fruit flavours are supported by a vibrant thread of lead pencil shavings from the elevated vineyards.

Steenberg 2020

Btl R610

(Wine of Origin: Constantia)

Elegant with soft dark fruit and characteristic notes of plum, liquorice and mulberry with a lively edge.

The nose offers cedarwood and lavender, while the broody and deep palate reveals raspberry preserve, umani and spice clove.

Hartenberg 2017

Btl R760

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Ripe, dark plums and chocolate on the nose with damp forest floor whiffs and clove spices.

The palate is plush and the plum note carries through, along with hints of cinnamon.

Fine grained tannins allow for a lingering finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Guardian Peak 2022

Btl R360 | Gls R90

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Bright aromas of blackberry, plum and red current with a savoury note of bay leaf. Fruit forward on the palate, with supple tannins and juicy flavours of black currant, mulberry, vanilla and chocolate.

Ernie Els Big Easy 2021

Btl R400 | Gls R100

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Fragrant aromas of Herb de Provence, wild rosemary, bay leaf, sorrel, leafy, savoury herbs mingle with fresh cassis, new spring plums and blackberries. Elegant oaking adds hints of ash, cedar and ground cinnamon to density of black fruit.

Hartenberg 2017

Btl R935

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Vibrant black cherry and blackcurrant on the nose under-pinned by aromas of fynbos and tobacco. Just ripe, juicy dark fruit is present on entry as well, showcasing an elegant and plush palate. Fine-grained, dry tannins prompt a lingering savoury and earthy finish

Rust en Vrede Estate

Btl R1500

Vineyards 2020

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Full-bodied and intense on the palate. Fine grained, grippy tannins balance well with a fresh, black-fruit acidity. Tobacco, nutmeg and savoury spice bring complex layers to mulberry and Bramble fruit that round out the palate. A typically well-structured Cabernet with excellent length.

Shiraz/Syrah

Guardian Peak 2021

Btl R360 | Gls R90

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Bright ruby with a purple rim. A spicy Shiraz with notes of pepper, toast and cured meat that combine with cranberry and a perfumed floral note. On the palate, mixed red and black berry flavours are supported by zesty acidity and crunchy tannins.

DeMorgenzon DMZ 2018

Btl R520 | Gls R130

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

This wine shows a deep plum colour and a bouquet that is intensely warm and perfumed in character, with distinctive hints of pepper and spice. The layers of rich berry fruits emerge beautifully and are rewarding on the palate.

Cederberg 2019

Btl R800

(Wine of Origin: Cederberg)

A complex Shiraz filled with intense red fruit, mulberry and cherries on the nose. 15 months in oak showing hints of sweet spice and vanilla. Red berries follow through on the palate and finish off with a smooth lingering sensation.

Rust en Vrede Estate

Btl R1100

Vineyards 2020

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Here is a fruit-focused Shiraz that puts forward just what one expects. Red cherry and plum fruit flavours backed by hints of black pepper and game. The fine tannins and medium body produce an overall structure that is approachable now.



Pinot Noir

Oak Valley Sounds of Silence 2021

Btl R720 | Gls R180

(Wine of Origin: Elgin)

An abundance of floral notes, a characteristic of this vintage, with some dry rose petal notes. The greener, earthy notes of beetroot and soil will emerge next. The palate is very fresh and juicy with fry strawberry, sour cherry, grapefruit and cranberry with a lengthy crunch finish.

De Grendel Op die Berg 2013

Btl R775

(Wine of Origin: Ceres)

Clear, bright garnet in colour with a plush array of fresh strawberries, ripe cherries and a hint of forest mushrooms.

A complex wine delivering excellent balance between fruit and oak flavours.

Catherine Marshall Sandstone 2020

Btl R785

(Wine of Origin: Elgin)

This wine embraces a minimalist and natural approach with attention to the integrity of Pinot Noir, specifically cultivated on lighter sandstone soils. Fresh pomegranate jewels, cranberry and red cherry top notes with underlying ferrous of savoury aromatics.

Red Blends

Alvi's Drift 221 Special

Btl R400 | Gls R100

Cuvee 2020

(Wine of Origin: Breede River Valley)
Intense black cherry coloured with youthful purple
shades, medium to full bodied with a spicy nose,
showcasing rich, ripe mulberries, red cherries and a hint

of lavender.

Mourvedre 2019

Btl R640 | Gls R160

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Vriesenhof Grenache/Shiraz/

This Grenache, based on Shiraz and Mourvedre, allows for the expression of diversity. A wine bursting with flavours of dark cherries, chocolate with beautiful savouriness and white pepper and a lingering finish of raspberries & leather.

Mulderbosch Faithful Hound Bordeaux Blend 2019

Btl R720

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

Alluring aromas of blueberry and mulberry supported by undertones of cassis. Blueberries and mulberries join coffee flavours to produce a well-structured, velvety soft wine.

Rupert & Rothschild Classique 2019

Btl R735

(Wine of Origin: Franschhoek)

Intense fruit flavours and ripe tannins that finish harmoniously on the palate. This well-balanced wine offers a pleasant balance between complexity and character.

Alvi's Drift The Bismarck 2018

Btl R1110

(Wine of Origin: Breede River Valley)

An opulent, full-bodied yet elegant wine with great complexity, exhibiting deep, dark, black fruit, ripe mulberry, spice, vanilla and just a hint of white pepper. This wine showcases well-rounded, velvety tannins with a long lingering aftertaste.

Meerlust Rubicon 2019

Btl R1720

(Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch)

A wonderfully complex aromatic array of black plum, blackberry compote, orange peel, Christmas pudding over hints of pressed violets, sweet cedar spice and graphite nuances.

Dessert Wines

Pierre Jordan Ratafia

Gls R75

(Wine of Origin: Franschhoek)

This fortified wine has a delicate yet enticing taste, while the nose is a melage of tropical fruit with vanilla overtones.

Klein Constantia Vin de Constance

Gls R360

(Wine of Origin: Klein Constantia)

A delicately perfumed yet elegant nose with flavours of white peach, citrus blossom and orange zest.

There is an intriguing creaminess on the nose followed by nutmeg and lemon curd. The palate abounds with complex flavours of oak spice, ginger and bright fruit.
